



Bert L. Thomas Endowed Scholarship Fund

The Bert L. Thomas Endowed Scholarship Fund was established in memory of Bert L. Thomas, a former trustee of Jacksonville University, by friends and associates at WinDixie Stores. Mr. Thomas was president of WinDixie at the time of his death, and memorial gifts were made by his friends, WinDixie suppliers and the WinDixie Company. After the initial gifts, a memorial golf tournament was held for several years to add to the corpus of the endowment fund. The tournament has been discontinued.

The purpose of the fund is to provide scholarship assistance to business majors who work to provide a portion of their college expenses.

Awards will be for \$1,000 or more, and may be renewed to juniors who remain in good standing.

Requirements:

- î X You must be an undergraduate junior, senior or graduate student at the time of application;
- ï X You must have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA;
- ô X You must submit a short essay telling a story about yourself for review by the scholarship committee;
- ñ X You must provide an unofficial transcript;
- ò X Preference given to students working to help pay for their educational expenses.
