Registration Instructions

START HERE: Go to www.citiprogram.org and click on the "Register" button located next to the blue login box to the right of the homepage.

The next steps are numbered 1-7. These steps will collect information to register your account and place you in the correct course based on JU's settings.

Step 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Enter "Jacksonville University" in the "Select Your Organization Affiliation" search box.- Click the box to "Agree to the Terms of Service".- Click "Continue to create your CITI username/password".
Step 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Enter your information in the appropriate boxes above, using your official JU email address as the primary email. You can include a personal email as the secondary option.- Click "Continue to Step 3".
Step 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Choose a username and password for your account. For security purposes, do NOT use your JU password on this website.- Select a security question and answer.- Click "Continue to Step 4".
Step 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- This step collects demographic information. Only the boxes with the red asterisk are required.- Click "Continue to Step 5".

- Click “Continue to Step 7”.

NEW CITI Learner Registration

1. For the basic Human Subjects Research modules, select the first option:

“Yes, I conduct research with live human beings, human samples or with data derived from human beings.”

- Click Next.

2. “Human Subjects Research (HSR) Training – IRB”: Select the type of research training required based on your learner group:

... Social-Behavioral-Educational Researcher (13 modules)

[Focus is on human beliefs, attitudes, and behaviors that are influenced by various social, biological and/or environmental factors. Data collection commonly involves surveys or questionnaires, interviews, focus groups, direct or participant observation, laboratory or field experiments, and non-invasive physical measurements.]

... Biomedical Researcher (14 modules)

[Conduct of basic, applied, and/or translational research that aims to contribute to the body of knowledge in the field of health and medicine.]
